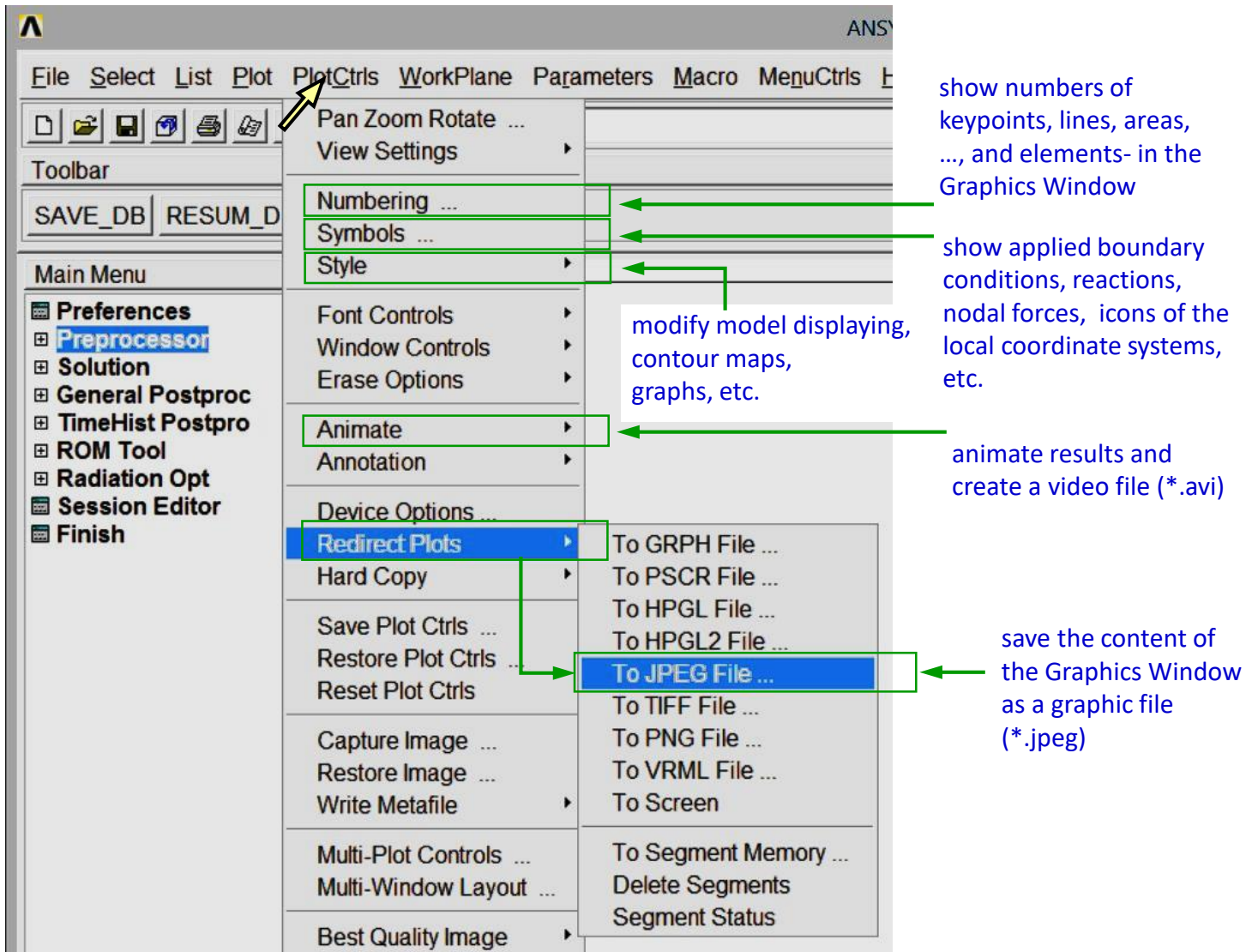

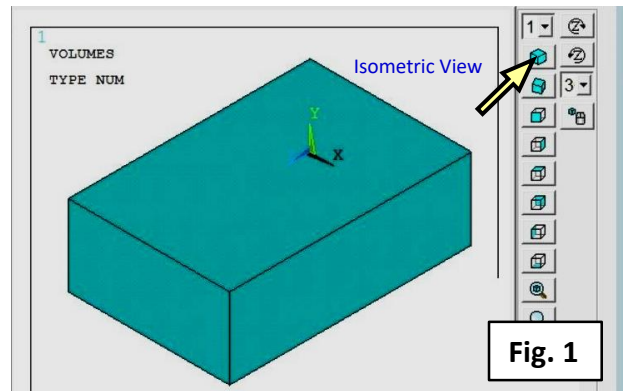
Menu PlotCtrls is used to modify the content of the Graphics Window. The difference between two menus: Plot and PlotCtrls is like for two questions: „What to plot?“ and „How to plot?“.

Clear and start a new database

Utility Menu > File > Clear & Start New > Do not Read File > OK > CLEAR ... EXECUTED? > Yes

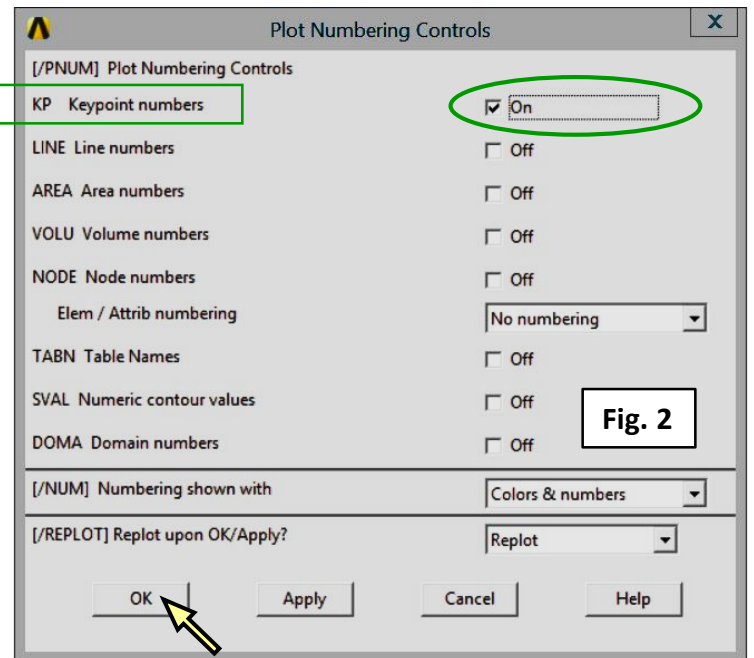
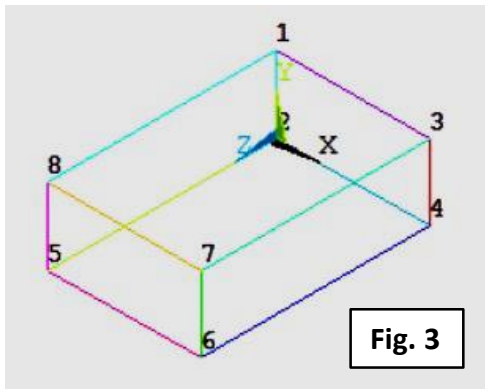
Create a block

Main Menu > Preprocessor > Modeling > Create >
 Volumes > Block > By Dimensions
 X1, X2 → 0, 100
 Y1, Y2 → 0, 50
 Z1, Z2 → 0, 150 → OK
 Set an isometric view (Fig. 1).



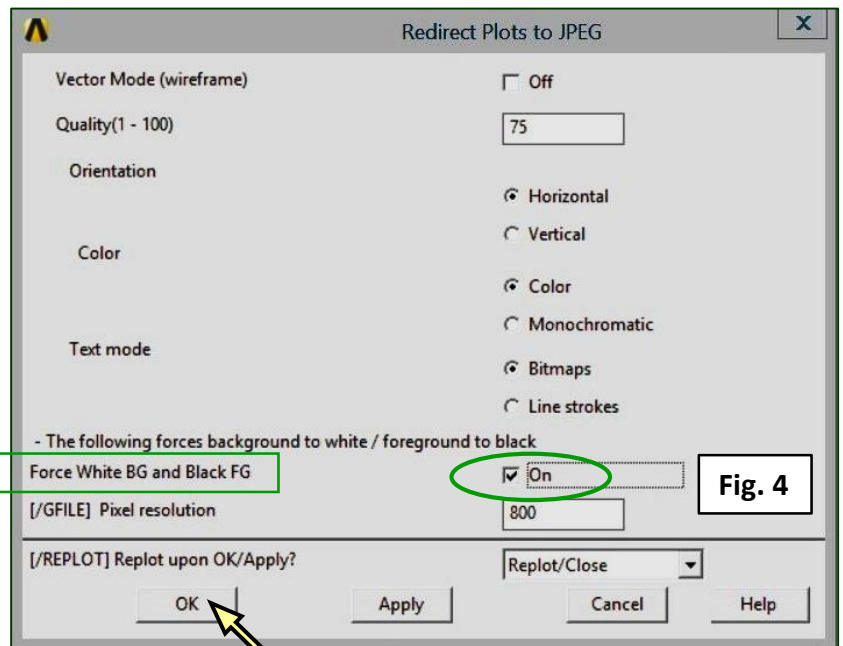
Show keypoint numbers

Utility Menu > PlotCtrls > Numbering... >
 Keypoint numbers > On → OK (Fig. 2)
 Utility Menu > Plot > Lines (Fig. 3)



Save lines with keypoint numbers as a graphic file

Utility Menu > PlotCtrls > Redirect Plots >
 To JPEG file > Force White BG & Black FG > On
 > OK (Fig. 4)
 The graphic file ,*.jpeg' is saved in
 a Working Directory (and shown in Fig. 3.).
